
Sean Bryan:

Technical Requirements:

Bump In- Approximately 2 hours Bump Out- Approximately 2 Hours Requires a venue technician to program *18* lighting cues.

Lighting- Can adapt to a standard rig. Requires a red pulsing light scene Requires one special to be rigged above the door.

Sound- Utilises venue sound system. 6 cues played from a Mac operating Qlab. No microphones.

Set-3 flats, 1 with door, 1 table, 2 foldable chairs, 1 metal bookshelf. Various set decoration items. Can be assembled by touring company. Set dimensions 6.6m long by 2.4m high
