Local hero Laser Beak Man works hard to keep it that way. Drawing energy from the underground Magna Crystals that power the City, his beak has the ability to shoot lasers that turn bad to good.

That is until Peter Bartman, evil genius, and Laser Beak Man's estranged childhood friend, steals the Magna Crystals using the Thriller Driller. Robbed of his super powers, Laser Beak Man must find a way to stop his oldest nemesis from destroying Power City.

In a story jam packed with the trademark humor and visual puns that come from his literal interpretation of language, Laser Beak Man is a new visual theater work under development by the Dead Puppet Society that explodes with colour and energy.

BACKGROUND

Tim Sharp, the creator of Laser Beak Man, was diagnosed with Autism when he was three years old. Doctors explained to his mother Judy that he would never speak and told her to put him away and forget about him. But Judy was determined to find a way to communicate with her son and introduced him to drawing. When he was eleven, Tim invented Laser Beak Man who allowed him to express his great sense of humor and intelligence as well as his quirky way of looking at the world. Since that time, Tim has become a globally recognised artist, receiving multiple awards and extensive media coverage both in Australia and overseas. In 2012 a short film about Tim was shown at the Metropolitan Museum of Modern Art in New York City, he has exhibited work at the Sydney Opera House, The National Museum of Australia, and in Washington DC and New York. At just 25 years of age he has twice been named as a finalist for the Young Australian of the Year.

COMPANY BIO

The Dead Puppet Society is Queensland's premiere visual theatre company based between Brisbane and New York City. They are currently in residence at The New Victory Theater to develop LASER BEAK MAN (2014-2016). They are also the company in residence at Queensland Theatre Company where they are developing THE WIDER EARTH (2014-2016), initially developed at St. Ann's Warehouse (2013-2014). Prior to this, the Society was mentored by Handspring Puppet Company (WAR HORSE) in South Africa which resulted in the creation of ARGUS (Brisbane Powerhouse 2013/National Tour 2015). Previous works include THE HARBINGER (La Boite Indie 2011/La Boite Theatre Company 2012/National Tour with Critical Stages 2014), THE TIMELY DEATH OF VICTORY BLOTT (Metro Arts 2010) and LITTLE GREY WOLF (UNDER THE RADAR, Brisbane Festival 2009/The Garden of Unearthly Delights, Adelaide Fringe 2010). The Society has received several awards from The Jim Henson Foundation for the creation of new work.




