

Technical Requirements

To guarantee a successful engagement for both parties, please review the following requirements.

1. Audio

(for smaller shows up to 200 people, Matt can supply a PA system on request)
Require a professional sound system suitable to cover entire function area INCLUDING stage/performance area (however inbuilt ceiling speaker system will not be suitable). It is important that there is sound coverage over the entire stage/performance area as this is an audience participation show and participants must be able to hear. Monitor(s) may be required if volunteers' chairs can't be placed in front of the main speakers. (SEE PHOTOS ON NEXT PAGE)

This system should contain:

1 wireless handheld microphone (Matt can supply on request)
The ability to plug Matt's ipad audio out into the PA system (using a DI if necessary) which is accessible side of stage by Matt during the performance

2. Lighting

A lighting system or existing venue lighting adequate to cover the working area of the stage. If a stage lighting system is being used, would prefer a bright stage wash with a bit of colour to warm it up. No follow spots necessary.

3. Stage

Appropriate stage that will allow artist and audience participants to be seen by audience. The stage should be large enough for subjects to be active during the performance, without the chance of them falling off stage. Steps to stage.

For small functions it is possible to work on a floor space rather than a stage, just as long as the audience have a clear view.

4. Chairs

Minimum (15) to maximum (25) straight back, armless chairs arranged on stage/performance area in a semi circle (half moon shape) facing the audience. Exact number based on your audience/stage size.

5. Table

Small table for the performance area.

6. Setup times/Soundcheck

Prefer to setup 2 hours before performance time and at least 1 hour before event starts, although shorter times can be discussed. Allow 10 minutes for soundcheck.

7. Performance scheduling

As this is an audience participation show, it is important to your event's success that no food is being served, eaten or cleared during the performance.
