- Wingham Akoostik Music Festival: <u>www.akoostik.com.au</u> Joe Camilleri, Ed Kuepper and heaps more artists. Should be perfect weather! About 15 minute drive from town, day tickets available at the gate.
- Manning Regional Art Gallery: <u>www.mrag.gtcc.nsw.gov.au</u> Really nice gallery in a converted heritage home. 2015 Manning Art Prize exhibition is on now
- Golf: If you're into that plenty of good golf courses around. Google Taree, Tallwoods or Forster golf courses.
- Go to Fays Twin Cinema and see The Martian (that's what I'll be doing!)
- Breakfast, lunch & dinner suggestions:
  - Flow Café in Old Bar (by the beach, 10mins from town): <u>www.flowbar.com.au</u> Local muso Matt Zarb is playing on Sunday afternoon 12:30-2:30. Lunch, beer, music, beach. Beat that. (Tell Matt I said hello) Also great for breakfast.
  - Bent on Food in Wingham (15mins from town): <u>www.bentonfood.com.au</u> Local produce, sit outside in the garden. Great for breakfast and lunch. Then go down the hill to Wingham Brush, walk through the rainforest and see the Flying Fox colony – they're pretty cool. You can then drive the 45mins up to Ellenborough Falls if you feel like it – one of the largest single-drop waterfalls in the southern hemisphere – walk to the bottom if you're feeling energetic.
  - If it's a nice day, head to Old Bar Beach. Right beside the surf club is Blowfish Street Food for lunch and coffee. Sit on the beach and bliss out.
  - o Jashan Lounge Indian Restaurant my choice for dinner
  - Italian old-school Italian, hasn't changed since the 80's. Big meals, low price, lots of garlic.
  - Fish Fish Fish Taree
  - Sailo's (Taree Aquatic Club) if you want good club-grub with a great view of the river.
  - Morning coffee: Raw Sugar in Victoria St (also good breakfast) or Jack
     & Co outside the Woolworth's shopping mall.
